Whats the Scoop?

Please think about these points when describing a story:

WHO OR WHAT , IS THE STORY ABOUT?

Who? (example: About a famous person getting arrested, dying, or winning a new sports contract)

-- OR --

What? (example: About a major storm that has flooded a large part of the united states)

MAIN POINT OF THE ARTICLE?

DETAILS?

When?

Where??

Why??

Conflict???

Person 1) Introduction, lead-in. Hands over to the other reporter.

Person 2) Follows on from the main story. Gives the details. Later hands back to first person.

Person 1) first person gives some closing comment for this article and moves to next item on the list.

Example 1.:

A) Anchor mentions the disasters in the country:

B) Weatherperson, stands in front of a map. Says: **"yes that's right Honza, ... "** and describes 5 main points. Finishes with **"... back to you, Honza"**

C) Anchor replies, **"Certainly a lot of damage in the midwest, some tragic scenes there today. Now we go to sports, and ... "**

Example 2. :

A) Anchor mentions the murder of a journalist and his girlfriend in slovakia. Tells audience, "Our reporter in Bratislava has more. Let's join Maruska live in Blava. Maruska can you hear me? What is the latest you have learned?"

B) Three slow seconds.... "Thanks Honza. Well not much new today except for the fact that police have released more disturbing details of the murders..."
